Come join us for education, fun, hands-on learning, entertainment, music and food, all in one beautiful setting.

La Cense Montana is hosting the Fundamentals of Horsemanship Festival at their ranch in Dillon where you will have the opportunity to learn the AQHAs Fundamentals of Horsemanship methods up close and personal at this one of a kind event. In addition to learning these techniques, there will be opportunities for many exciting activities.

Friday, May 29th is Youth Fun and Education Day. The AQHA will host Judging Halter Classes and Junior Master Horseman Activities. La Cense will give a Horse Demonstration that showcases the Fundamentals of Horsemanship that was developed using the La Cense Method. UMW students will show what they have learned while working towards their degrees in Natural Horsemanship.

Saturday, May 30th, will include numerous activities such as demos by La Cense Montana and UMW students, lectures on the Fundamentals concept and education sessions, and equine nutrition. Youth will have opportunities for learning about the Horsemanship program at the University of Montana Western, which has the only 4-year degree in Natural Horsemanship in the country. La Cense will also introduce the first Professional School of Horsemanship.

Pre-registration is required for the youth groups as well as a signed release form from parents. A chaperone with a cell phone is also required for each group in case of any emergencies.

The Youth Fun Day begins with orientation at 9:00 AM, and will break for lunch from noon until 1:00. Lectures, classes, and demos will continue until 4:30 with dinner at 5:30. After dinner, there will be numerous evening activities including a UMW tour, movie and open mic jam session. Once a group is pre-registered, they will receive a packet with an ID badge that will have a place for emergency contacts, allergies, etc. as well as information from the AQHA.
